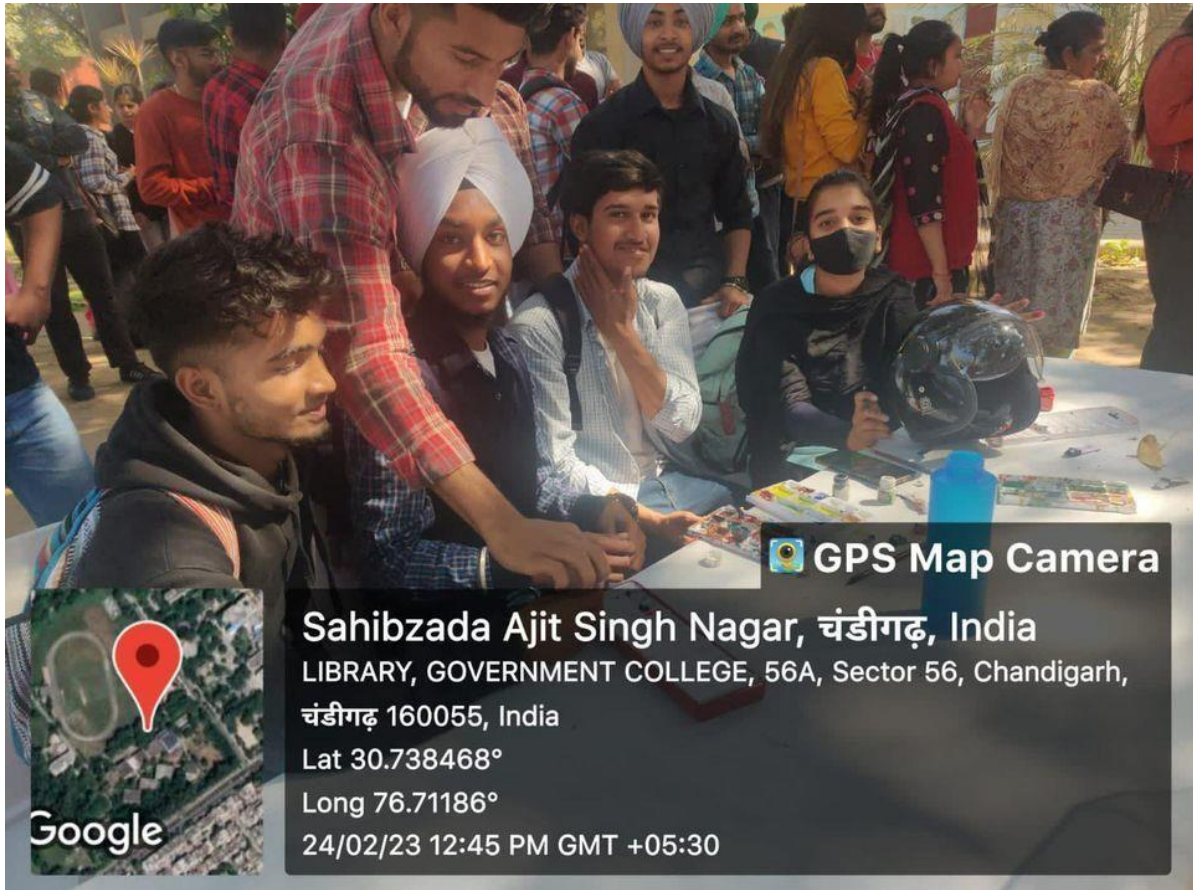

World DNA Day Celebration at AIIMS, Mohali

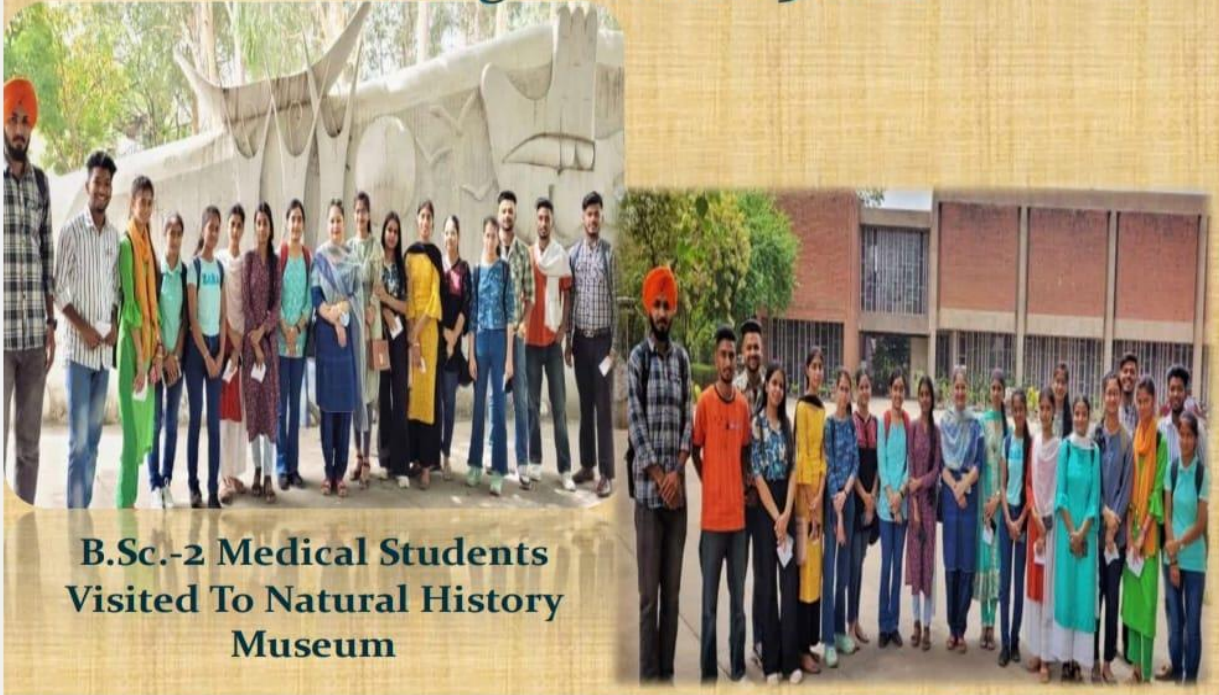

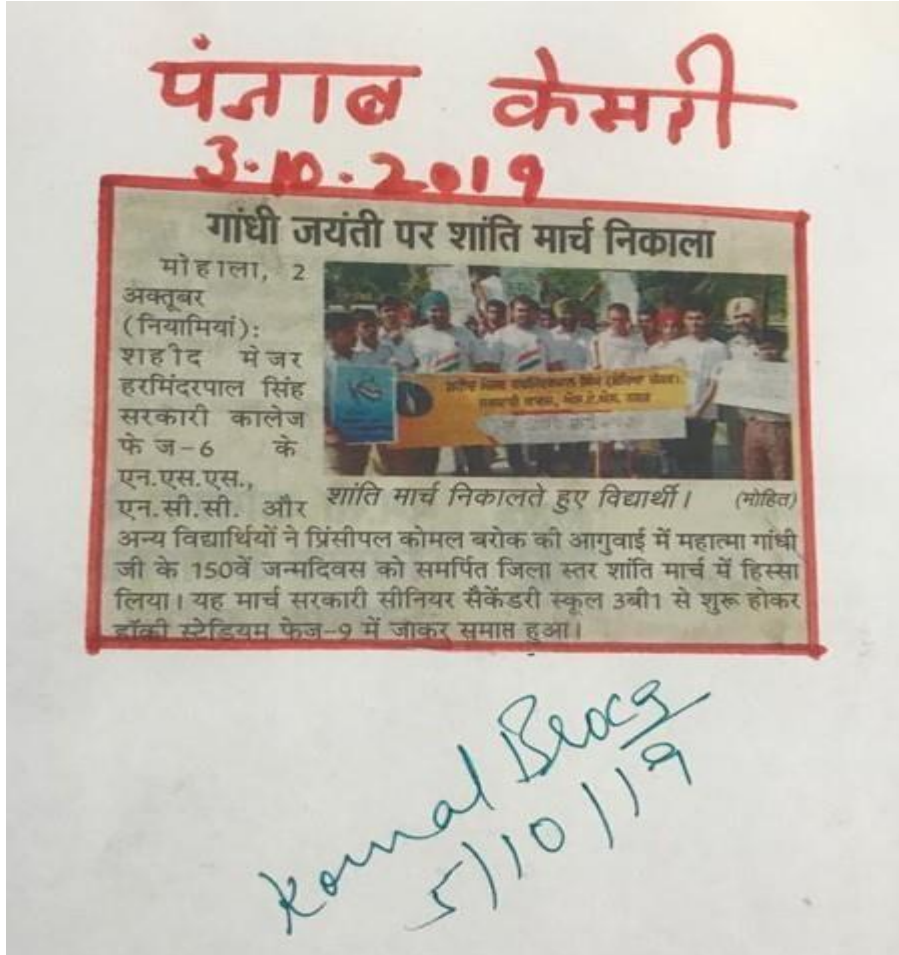

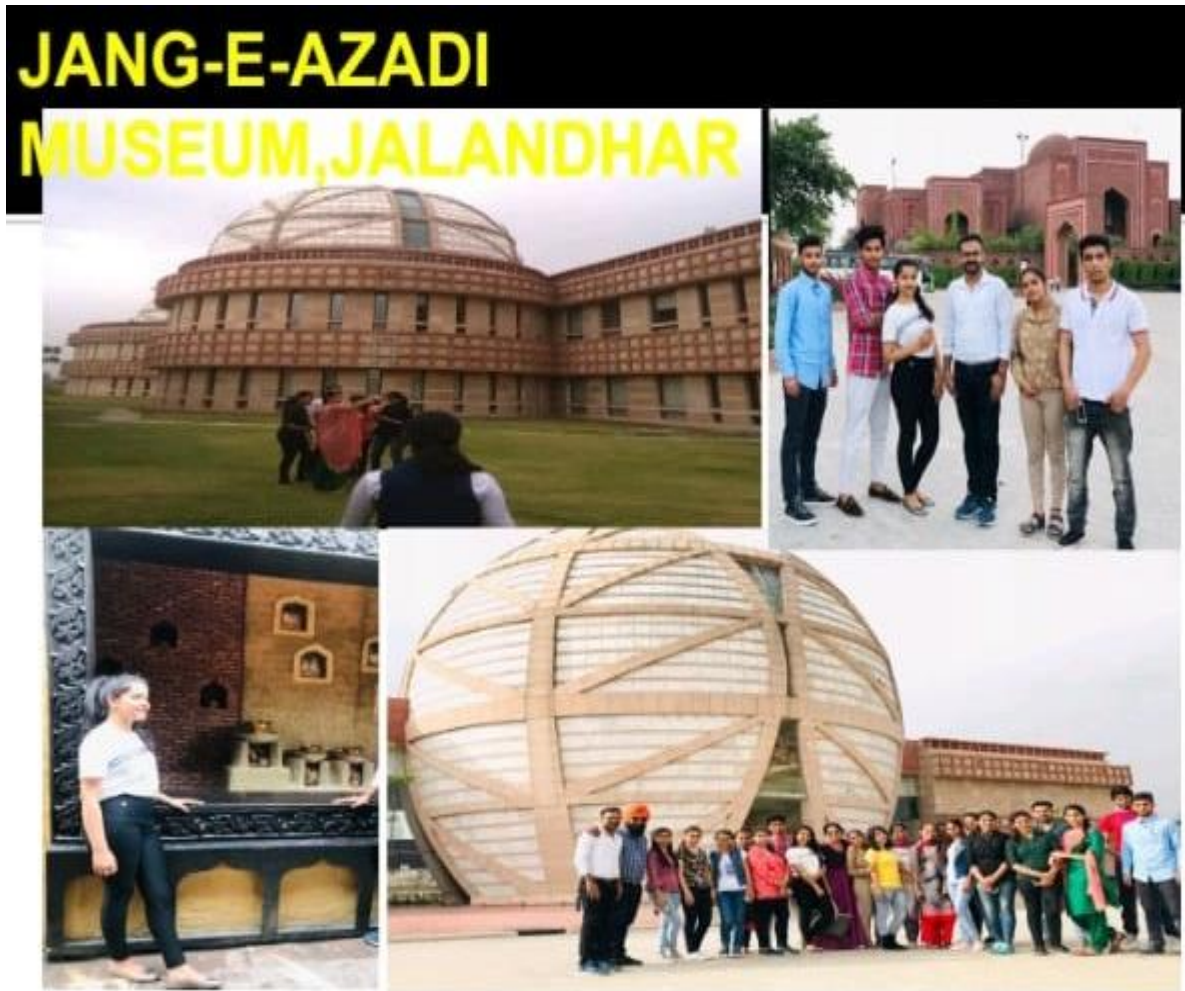
