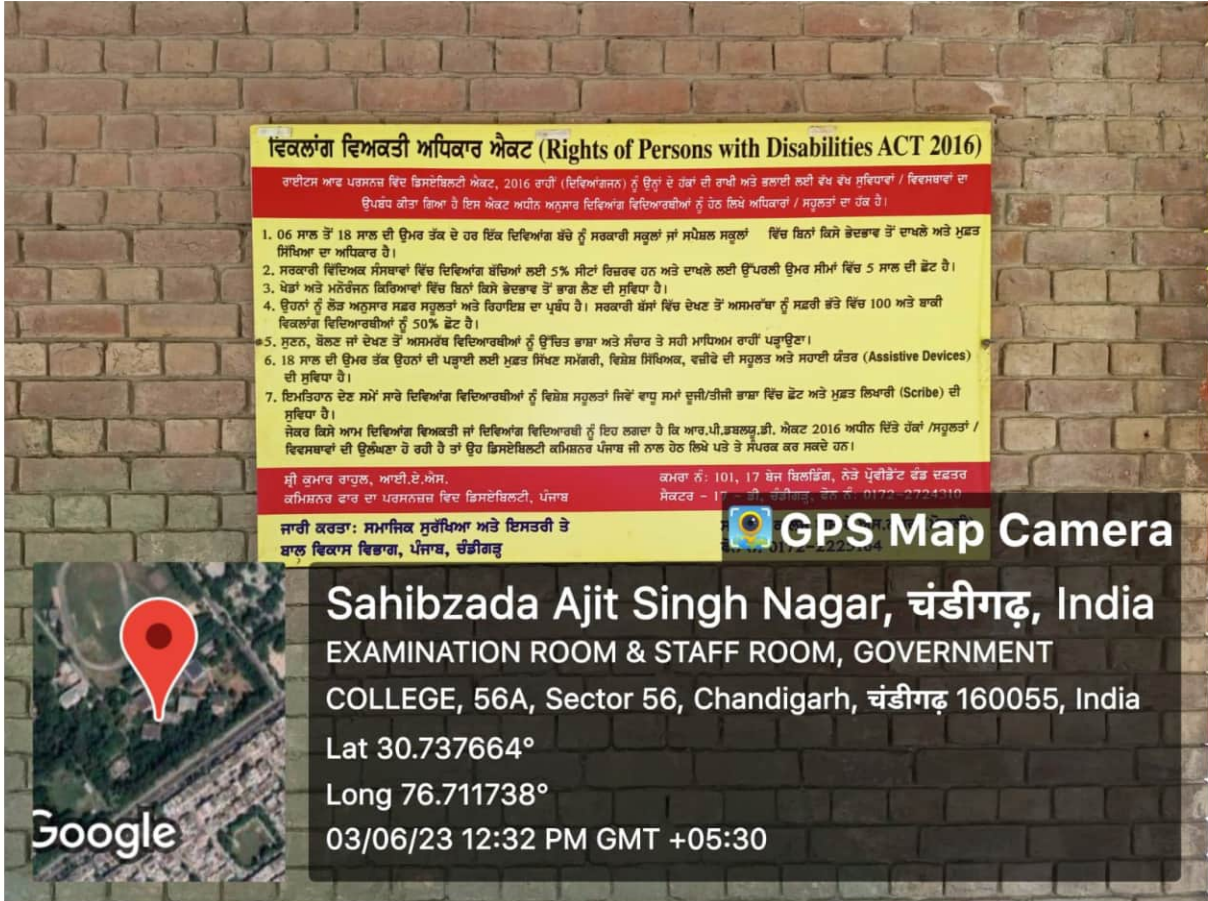


Geo-tagged Photographs



The points in the photograph state that:

1. Differently abled children between the ages of 6 to 18 years are to be granted admission to government schools or colleges without bias and with free education.
2. 5% of seats in all educational institutions should be reserved for disabled students, and an age relaxation of 5 years should be provided to them.
3. These students must be allowed to participate in different activities without any discrimination.
4. Travel allowances should be provided to these students. In government buses, visually impaired students have 100% rebate and students with other forms of disability have 50% rebate in the bus fare.
5. Visually-impaired, hearing-impaired and speech-impaired students should be taught using right means of communication.


The institution has a disabled-friendly, barrier-free environment.

- Apart from adopting appropriate medium and effective methods of teaching for differently-abled students, their inclusion and effectiveness in curricular and co-curricular activities have always been a prime objective of the college. All the teaching-learning activities are designed on the basis of inclusive education.
- Individuals with a disability can freely and safely move around with the help of ramps and rails installed in different sections of the college campus. The differently-abled students can participate in routine activities without any hassle.
- All the staircases are accompanied by rails. Ramps, which are inclined planes have also been built for the safe passage of the differently-abled.
- Students and employees are encouraged to attend disability awareness courses as part of their induction training.
- Two restrooms have been specially constructed for people with disabilities.
- The fixtures and fittings in these restrooms are comfortable and convenient to use.
- The differently-abled have easy access to the non-slip floor, sliding door and handles.
- Signboards have also been set up at various locations in the college indicating the path to be taken to go to a specific department.
