> Anti Drug Cycle Rally - NCC girl cadets participated in Anti-drug Cycle Rally on May 20, 2022.



> National Science Day- The Science depts.. of the college observed 28/02/2022 as the Science day with the theme of Integrated Approac in Science & Technology.






